Do you know that the San Francisco Food Bank collects, sorts, repackages and distributes thousands of pounds of food every day? This year, the Food Bank will send 36.5 million pounds of food out to communities in San Francisco and Marin counties. That's enough for over 78,000 meals every day.

Once again, Argonne is participating in a food drive to support the SF Food Bank. Due to the high demand for and limited availability of collection barrels from the Food Bank, Argonne will not receive collection barrels until next week, December 9. In the interim, we will provide boxes by the front door beginning today so that we can begin to collect your contributions.
